Chardel Hastings, Southeast Kansas Multi-County Health Department, announced that the Health Department will be administering the Allen County WIC Program beginning in October.

Jason Trego, Emergency Management Director, spoke about an emergency response exercise he attended in Bourbon County on July 11<sup>th</sup>.

Angela reminded the Committee that there is an active shooter exercise scheduled for August 11, at the Moran Public Schools. It is open for the LEPC membership to attend.
